CEREAL CROP

- 1. Choose one cereal crop and describe how it is grown. Use the following headings.
- a) Name of cereal crop / field crop
 - maize; sorghum; millet; rapoko;
- b) Climate requrements
 - Grown in summer
 - Requires warm climates
 - Rainfall not let than 600mm
- c) Land preparation
 - Clearing bushes and trees by stumping
 - Leveling the soil
 - Ploughing deep 300mm
 - Applying manure compound D & Ammonium nitrate

d) Planting

- Plant in summer
- Use a hoe or machine to plant seeds
- Add compound D during planting
- Add ammonium nitrate or top dressing after germination
- e) Spacing
 - Between rows 90cm
 - Between plants 30cm
- f) Harvesting
 - Use a combine harvester
 - Use manual hands
 - Dry the crop before storing
- g) Pests and diseases
 - Weeds
 - Cutworms
 - Stalk borer
 - Birds
 - Locust

VEGETABLE CROP

- 2. Choose one vegetable and describe how it is grown. Use the following headings.
- a) Name of vegetable crop / garden crop
 - Tomatoes; Peppers; egg plant;
- b) Climate requrements
 - Grown in summer under irrigation
 - Grown throughout the year
- c) Land preparation
 - Clearing bushes and trees by stumping
 - Leveling the soil
 - Ploughing or dig to a depth of 30cm
 - Applying single super phosphate to the soil

d) Planting

- Plant mostly in summer
- Raised in a nursery
- Transplant healthy seedlings when 8 weeks old
- e) Spacing
 - Between rows 60-90cm
 - Between plants 30-45cm
- f) Harvesting
 - Use a machine or manual hands
 - Harvest when they turn pink (blossom colour)
 - Store in a cool dry place so that they do not rot
- g) Pests and diseases
 - Affected by frost
 - Red spider mites
 - Cut worms
- h) Benefits
 - Vitamin A; B and C
